

Power Cup Terms and Conditions

1. General Information

Power Cup is the world's largest volleyball tournament for children and youth. Every year, more than 850 teams and over 7,500 visitors participate in this four-day sports event, which is held every other year in a different location across Finland. The event features players of all ages, from pre-school children to 22-year-olds, each competing in their own age categories. All matches are officiated by the players themselves when they are not playing.

2. Tournament Pass Contents

The tournament pass provides many benefits for participants:

- Playing, match schedule, and results service throughout the four-day tournament.
- School accommodation.
- Meals from Thursday lunch to Sunday lunch (7 hot meals), for the weekend pass from Friday lunch to Sunday lunch (5 hot meals), and breakfast and evening snacks.
- Tournament t-shirt and pass bag.
- Valuable offers from our partners in the tournament city.
- Side programs: Opening ceremony, activities in Power Square, activation points, and the Tournament Disco.

3. Participation Fees

Every player, coach, and team member participating in Power Cup must have event pass. Obtaining an event pass (i.e., paying the participation fee) is a requirement for participation.

- **Event pass** covers the tournament from Thursday to Sunday.

4. Additional Services

- **Additional Night**

The cost for an additional night between Wednesday and Thursday is:

- €20 per person
- The additional night includes school accommodation and breakfast on Thursday, as well as Wednesday evening snack. Booking an additional night is binding and non-refundable if the participation is canceled.

- **Other Passes**

These are free of charge (0 € per person) and intended for people who facilitate the team/player's participation but do not themselves participate in the tournament.

- Bus driver basic pass / for bus drivers staying at the school.
- Assistant basic pass / for those assisting a player on a personal basis, staying at the school.

- **Transportation Fee**

The transportation fee is €35 per person. Transportation can be booked for two weeks after the end of the 2nd registration period. A link to book transportation will be sent to the team's contact person. Booking transportation is binding and non-refundable if participation is canceled.

- **Change Fee**

Power Cup charges a €20 change fee for any changes made after the registration period ends (e.g., player transfers).

5. Special Diets

Power Cup is a big event, and special diets, including lactose-free, dairy-free, gluten-free, and vegetarian options, can be noticed.

The following meals are included in the participation fee (tournament pass):

- **Basic Pass:** Thursday lunch to Sunday lunch (7 hot meals)
- Breakfast and evening meal for school accommodation guests.
- Breakfast and evening meal are available for those staying elsewhere.

Morning and Evening meal include:

- Bread (also gluten-free option)
- Spread (dairy-free, lactose-free)
- Cold cuts (chicken/turkey/ham)
- Cheese (lactose-free)
- Cucumber, bell pepper, tomato
- Fruit: Banana, apple, mandarin
- Juice box
- Muesli
- Yogurt (also dairy-free and lactose-free options)
- Smoothie/Soup (berry/fruit-based)
- Nuts bar (also nut-free, gluten-free, dairy-free options)
- Milk (lactose-free)

Important:

If a participant has a special diet not listed above, it will be accommodated for lunch and dinner if the details are provided during registration in the “Other” section. Special diet information must be provided no later than the end of the 2nd registration period.

For breakfast and evening meals, participants are responsible for their own food if none of the above options suit their diet. Due to the size of the event, the organizer cannot accommodate special diets beyond those mentioned above.

6. Billing and Payment Terms

Power Cup will send a single invoice to the club, with a team breakdown.

The invoice will be sent after the registration period ends to the provided billing address.

Payment terms are 14 days. If the invoice is not paid by the due date, team cant participate to the tournament.

7. Cancellation Terms

Registration is binding, and the participation fee can only be refunded with a medical certificate. Refunds for participation fees can be requested up to two weeks after the event.

In the case of a refund, the cancellation fee is €180 per participant, regardless of which registration period the participation was purchased in. Any pre-booked and paid additional services, such as extra nights, transportation, and other extra purchases, will not be refunded. The team fee is not refunded in case of cancellation.

8. Price Changes

Power Cup reserves the right to change event prices at any time. However, these changes do not apply to already made and paid participation fees and additional purchases, which will follow the prices valid at the time of purchase.

9. Marketing Terms

During the event, Power Cup will produce marketing materials that include photos and videos featuring participants.

Material created from the event will be used as part of Power Cup's product and event marketing. This content will be shared with the organizing club's media channels and Power Cup's partners outside of the Volleyball Federation's platforms.

10. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

These terms are governed by Finnish law, excluding conflict of law rules. Any disputes will primarily be resolved through negotiations between the parties. If negotiations fail, the disputes will be resolved in the Helsinki District Court. A consumer may, however, always file a claim or be a defendant in their local district court. In case of disputes, consumers can also approach the Consumer Disputes Board (kuluttajariita.fi) or the European Commission's online dispute resolution platform (ec.europa.eu/odr).
